The number of workers and hours ONLY not money.

You **MUST** wear a badge or Auxiliary-branded attire (shirt, hat, jacket, etc.) when you do a Community Outreach program. This will make us visible and show our pride in the VFW Auxiliary

### **Examples of Auxiliary Community Outreach include but not limited to:**

- \*Honor First Responders
- \*Hosting a Blood Drive
- \*Tutoring or reading to students
- \*Meals on wheels
- \*Joint programs with American Cancer, Alzheimer's Group, American Diabetes
- \*Working with Police or Fire Departments on Safety programs
- \*Local humane societies or animal rescue groups
- \*Backpack meals for kids on weekends

### **Please Note:**

\*Auxiliary Community Outreach is for projects **NOT AFFILIATED** with VFW or VFW Auxiliary Programs.  
\*Volunteer work that is performed for the benefit of the Post or Auxiliary is **NOT** considered community service. Examples of projects that do not qualify include: Cooking or serving a meal for a Post or Auxiliary fundraiser; "Buddy" Poppy distribution; Church activities for one specific congregation and not the entire community.

Yes, our Community Outreach Program is to reach out to other organizations and assist them with projects that benefit your community, but we can also co-sponsor those programs or events. Success will be ours if we properly plan, promote and complete each project. Positive, effective promotion of our organization will increase public awareness and recognition. The name of the game is **REPORT – REPORT – REPORT**.

To have every Auxiliary in Texas be able to fill out the National Auxiliary Community Outreach Award for Auxiliaries No. 1 entry form. That would mean every Auxiliary participated in a community event.

3. Plaque to an Auxiliary in each Membership Division with the **Best Collective Community Outreach Projects**. This will include number of projects, workers and hours. Citation 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.
